# Digital tools and the pandemic impact



77% of participants use digital tools to support teaching activities



### Frequently used tools

Videos, online learning environments (Moodle, Google Classroom), presentations (PPT), and apps or games



**49%** reported facing obstacles, mainly related to internet access (**24%**), tool functionality issues (**23%**), and availability of adequate tools (**19%**)



**93%** of participants believe that the health emergency has spurred the use of digital resources in language teaching



While **65%** of teachers believe the pandemic boosted their digital skills, a striking **97%** still recognize a pressing need for further improvement









60% are familiar with AI tools,yet only 25% have actually used them.81% of teachers are interested in training opportunities

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Only **37%** are aware of the DigCompEdu framework. Most teachers self-assess as "Integrators (B1)" (41%), followed by "Explorers (A2)" (25%) and "Experts (B2)" (21%)


Students with learning difficulties 77% believe that digital tools can improve their learning experience.
Yet, despite 71% feeling they have enough materials, 79% consider specific training in this area essential.






